Farmers Federation Declares Dividend

A semi-annual dividend of three per cent payable January 1, to stockholders of record December 16, 1940 has been declared by the directors of the Farmers Federation, Inc.

More than 4,500 stockholders in Western North Carolina will share in this distribution which is the Federation's 14th consecutive semi-annual dividend. Checks will be mailed to the holders of preferred shares, while the majority of common stockholders will be paid in cash at the nearest Farmers Federation warehouse.

The directors also announced a dividend of three per cent on partial paid stock in the Federation. These shares have been accumulated as a result of the three per cent patronage which for several years the Federation has distributed in stock on partial paid stock will be paid in credits toward full stock shares which, when completed will entitle the holders to regular cash dividends.
