Hazelwood Blanks Bryson City, 9-0

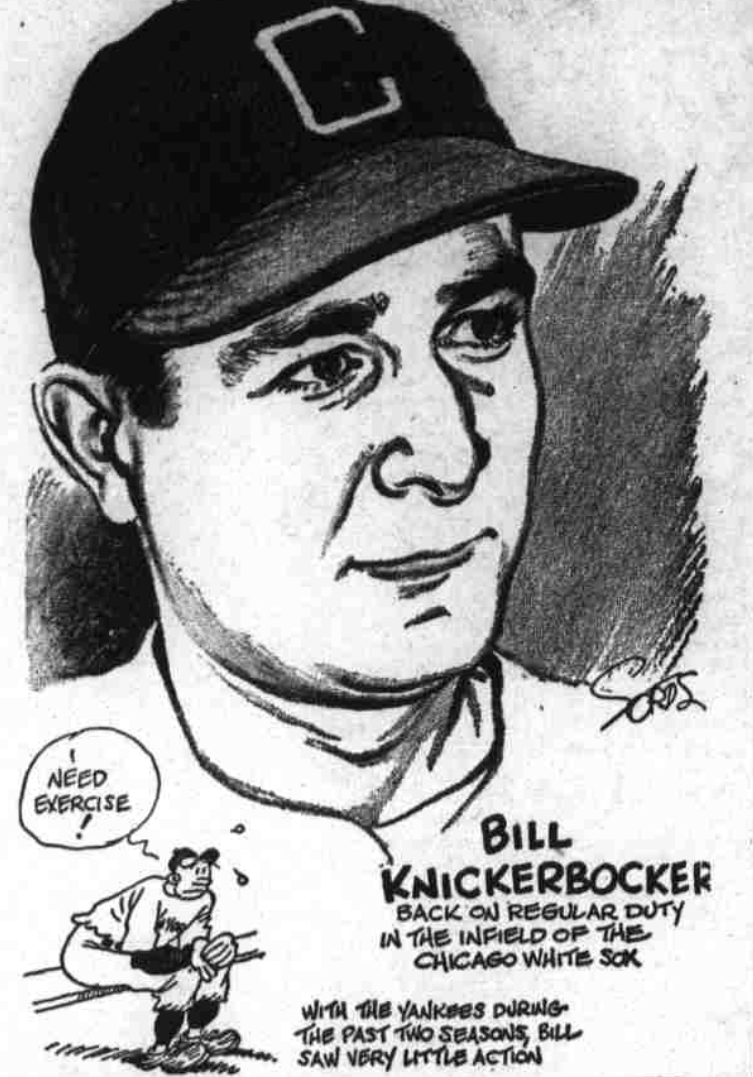

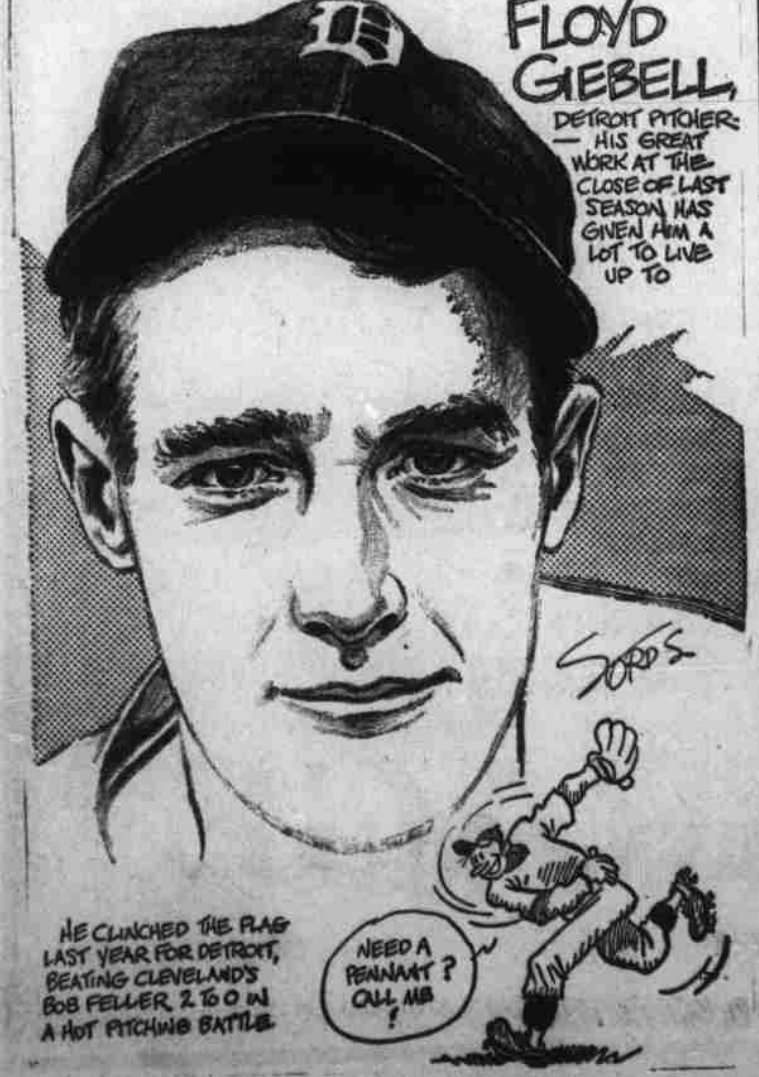
