

Unattended Vehicle Sec. 125, Motor Vehicle Laws of North Carolina:- "No person having control or charge of a motor vehicle shall allow such vehicle to stands on highway unattended with out first setting the brakes thereon and stopping the motor of said vehicle and when standing upon any grade without turning the front wheels of such vehicle to the curb

or side of the highway." In other words, before leaving a vehicle parked with no one in it, be sure that the motor is cut off and that the emergency brake is on, and if parked on a grade, see that the front wheels are cut toward the curb or side of the roadway. At night be sure to leave your parking lights on.
