

Mountaineers Begin Football Practice 25th

About Fifty Boys Expected To Be On Hand For Work

Hard Schedule On Foot For Weatherby Men; Many Men Lost By Graduation.

The thud of the pigskin will be heard once more Monday evening, August 25, as the first football practice of the Mountaineers gets underway.
