MONEY-The Advisory Budget Commission last fall recommended the expenditure during the next fiscal year \$63,000,000 from the General Fund \$41,000,000 of this will go to schools), and the amount expected to be taken into the General Fund for the next fiscal year has been estimated at about \$65,000,000.

The recommendations have been set within \$2,000,000 of estimated expenditures, Gov. Cherry says he won't permit spending more than is taken in, so how can any big idealistic programs be undertaken-unless we want to go in the hole again as we did under Gardner' administration?

FIGURES-Due to the fact that much of this State's revenue comes from sales tax, intangibles, and incomes, North Carolina's income is closely linked with the Nation's business. We figure that we will have an income in this State of one-half million dollars for every billion taken in for the United States. Last year, the Nation's income was around 150 billion, and this State's was 76 million.

The estimate for this year for the Nation is around 130 billion from January 1 through Decem ber 31, the calendar year.
