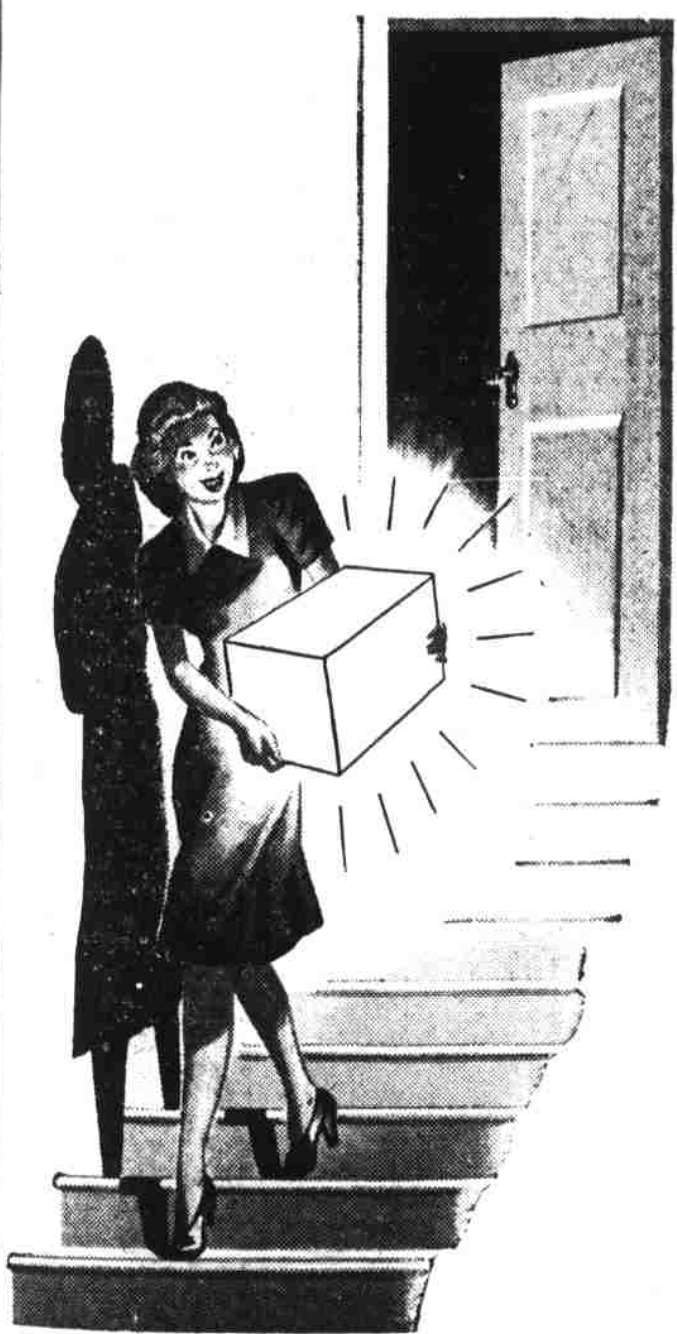

**Sgt. Erwin Wins
Distinguished
Unit Citation**

Sgt. Troy E. Erwin, son of Mr. and Mrs. Thomas Erwin, of Canton, R.F.D. No. 3, has recently been awarded the Distinguished Unit Citation. The following is taken from a letter setting forth the outstanding performance of duty in action by the unit:

"In the invasion of France the 741st Tank Battalion rendered outstanding performance of duty in action against the enemy on the Colleville beach on 6th and 7th June, 1944. Armored units of the battalion led the assaults wave in landing in the face of extensive and elaborate enemy minefields, which had been cleared or gapped and under the withering artillery, anti-tank, machine gun and mortar fire from organized and fortified enemy positions. In spite of the extremely heavy losses the attack was aggressively pushed against the unexpectedly still enemy resistance, and thereby enabling the infantry to hold the beach.

When planned exits from the beach were unusable due to enemy installation road blocks, minefields, and fortifications, the 741st tank battalion forced new exits from the beach against the enemy positions and by such actions enabled a beach line to be secured and held, insuring success of the landing and the beachhead. The courage and devotion to duty shown by the members of the 741st tank battalion are worthy of emulation and reflect the highest traditions of the army of the United States.

"The Distinguished Unit Citation is awarded to a unit whose battlefield records, in such that if the same or similar acts were performed by an individual, that individual would be entitled to the Distinguished Cross."

Sgt. Erwin entered the service on February 19, 1942, and was inducted at Fort Jackson. He trained at a number of camps prior to being sent overseas where he was first stationed in England. Since then he has seen action in France on D-Day, in Belgium, and Germany.

At the time he entered the service he was shovel operator for Lowdermilk Construction Co. He has a brother, Robert H. Erwin, who is now serving in France.

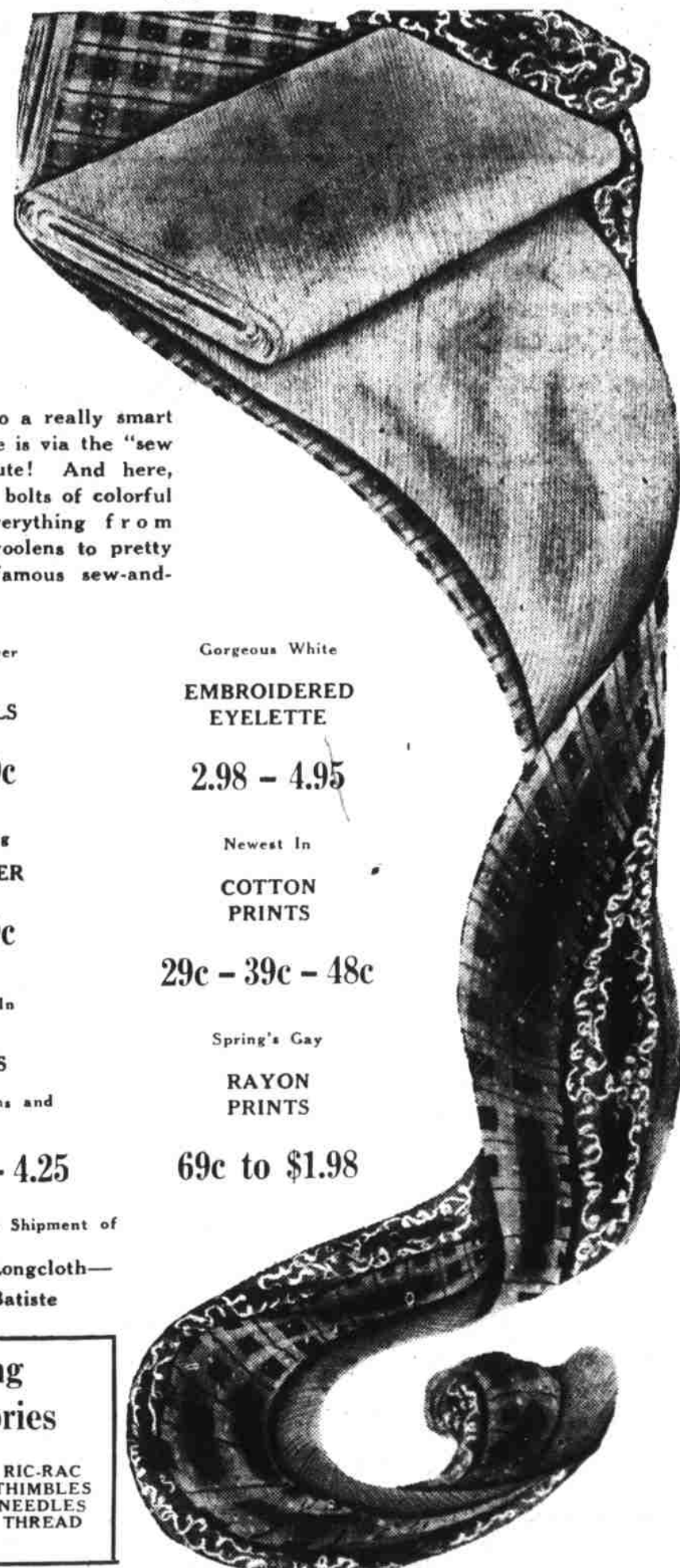
