Private Humes Hart, Jr. Will Enter State College

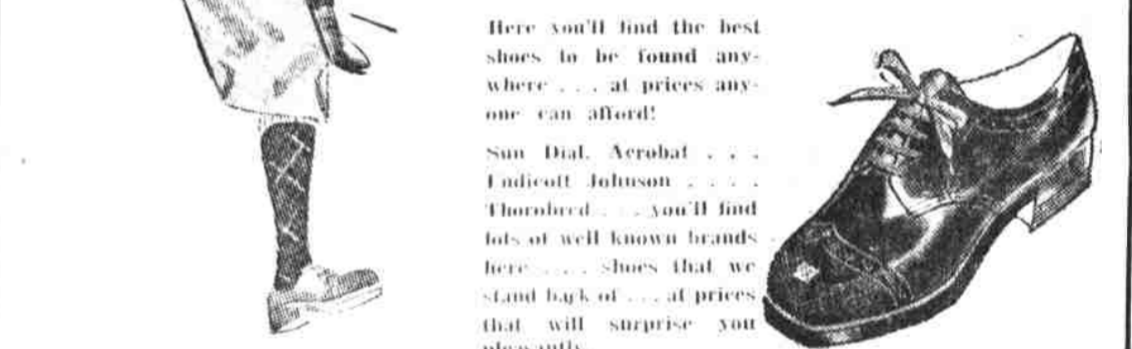
