Survey Shows Veterans Want Government Jobs

Approximately five per cent of the men in the Army have definite plans to get a government job after discharge, and an additional five per cent think they will probably seek government employment but do not have clearly formulated plans.

Two-thirds of the men who have definite plans for governmental employment after discharge were in government jobs before entering the Army, the report states.

The report also emphasizes that in the long run "the number of veterans who will seek employment in the Federal, state or local government will depend upon the general availability and attractiveness of government jobs as against jobs offered by private industry."

Nearly half the enlisted men who are planning to work for the Federal government wish clerical positions, and about 30 per cent desire jobs in skilled, semi-skilled or unskilled occupations.
