Building & Loan Reduce Interest Rate To 5 Percent

L. N. Davis, secretary-treasurer of Haywood Home Building & Loan Association, which was organized in 1919 by a group of local citizens who were interested in the general welfare of the community and seeking to formulate a plan whereby the working man without capital could become the owner of a

home, announces elsewhere in this week's issue of The Mountaineer that the Association will, as of April 1st, commence making mortgage loans under the Direct Reduction Loan Plan, at five percent interest per annum.

Placing mortgage loan payments on a monthly basis, and providing for consistent amortization of principal constitute important innovations in mortgage practice during recent years. Most popular is the Direct Reduction Loan which calls for an equal payment each month over a definite term of years. The Federal Housing Administration has publicized this type of loan extensively, and it is now widely used by Federal Savings & Loan Associations and Building & Loan Associations.

The action of this local institution was taken as a forward step and is in keeping with the trend of home ownership. This plan of home financing qualifies the Association to make veterans loans under the GI Bill of Rights as well as Federal Housing Administration loans.
