Atlantic Charter Set Allied Goal For 'Better World'

Establishment of democratic government, promotion of world prosperity through free access to trade and raw materials, and disarmament of aggressor nations to maintain peace—these U. S. and British ambitions for a better world were officially expressed in the historic Atlantic Charter drawn up by President Roosevelt and Prime Minister Churchill early in August, 1941, on the high seas off the North American coast.

In their declaration of principles, the two leaders avowed their countries' disinterest in territorial aggrandizement, and also pledged to work with smaller nations in the realization of their broad objectives.
