- 4. Keep on salvaging urgently needed tin cans. Japan still controls all sources of our pre-war tin supply.

LIVESTOCK SLAUGHTERERS MUST FILE REPORTS WITH OPA

All Class 2 slaughterers will be required to file reports with their OPA district offices within 30 days after the close of each slaughter period. The reports should show the total number of live-stock slaughtered during the period and the number of live-stock slaughtered during the period.
