## F. Federation Declares Semi-Annual Dividend

Directors of the Farmers Federation have just declared the 26th consecutive semi-annual dividend to stockholders, James G. K. McClure, president, announced. This dividend will be payable July 1 to stockholders of record June 15. 1945.

The regular semi-annual dividend on common stock is 3%, he said. This will be paid in cash at the warehouses after July 1. and members of the Farmers Federation should call for their money there. The regular semi-annual dividend on preferred stock was declared, and checks covering the payment of this dividend will be mailed to stockholders.

The directors authorized an addition to be built to the Hendersonville frozen food lockers. Mr. McClure said. The plant now has 498 lockers, the addition will provide 250 more. So great has been the demand for lockers that these are expected to be rented in advance, mainly by persons whose




