

### Social Security Pays 54 Haywood Persons \$3,554 Every Month

Report From District Shows Benefits Being Paid

The largest amount goes to 128 children under 18 who are paid a total of \$1,406.50 each month while the five widows over 65 receive a total of \$16.90.

There are 42 young widows with children who draw \$630.51 a month. The report shows there are no aged dependents of deceased workers, which the act also care for.

The district office in Asheville is now paying out \$41,533.06 per month to 2,949 persons.

D. W. Lambert, manager of this district, pointed out in making the report that there are two times for action under the present Social Security act for a person to keep in mind. First, the wage earner should always make contact with the field office when the age of 65 is reached. Second, surviving relatives should always inquire at once in case of death of a wage earner.

### Judge From Orient Says Japs Started War Because America Was Unprepared

The Japanese were confident they could defeat the United States back in 1941, said Judge George A. Malcom, former commissioner to the Philippines, and authority on the Far East, in an address at the Rotary Club here last Friday.

There would not have been a war in the Pacific had America been "prepared," he continued, pointing out that this nation was the only large country unprepared for a Japanese war.

The speaker spent 32 years in the Orient and traced the history of the Philippines, and paying much tribute to the late Presidents William Howard Taft and Woodrow Wilson, for their method in handling the Philippines and setting up policies which led to their independence being granted on next July Fourth.

Judge Malcom is among the group that feels the Philippines have earned and deserve their independence next July. "We must go through with our promise, for more reasons than one and one of them is to combat the propaganda of the Japanese. Out of every 100 citizens of the Philippines, 98 want their independence, and the two are from the northern part and afraid to act because of

Japanese pressure. The speaker said Harold S. Ekers, Sec. of the Interior, and Paul A. McNulty of the War Relocation Authority, and other officials, should support their independence, which General MacArthur has already in favor of a long time.

Today, he pointed out, the Philippines are not a nation, but a collection of islands.

"The Japanese are trying to create a united front on the side of the colored races, and the whites. The Chinese and the Philippines have not their full attention to the Japanese propaganda on this line, but it is time to call a halt to it."

Judge Malcom called for a stern peace and reconstruction program for the Japanese and urged that America must keep a watchful eye for future wars.
