Rev. Williamson Will Attend Synod Of Appalachia Next Week

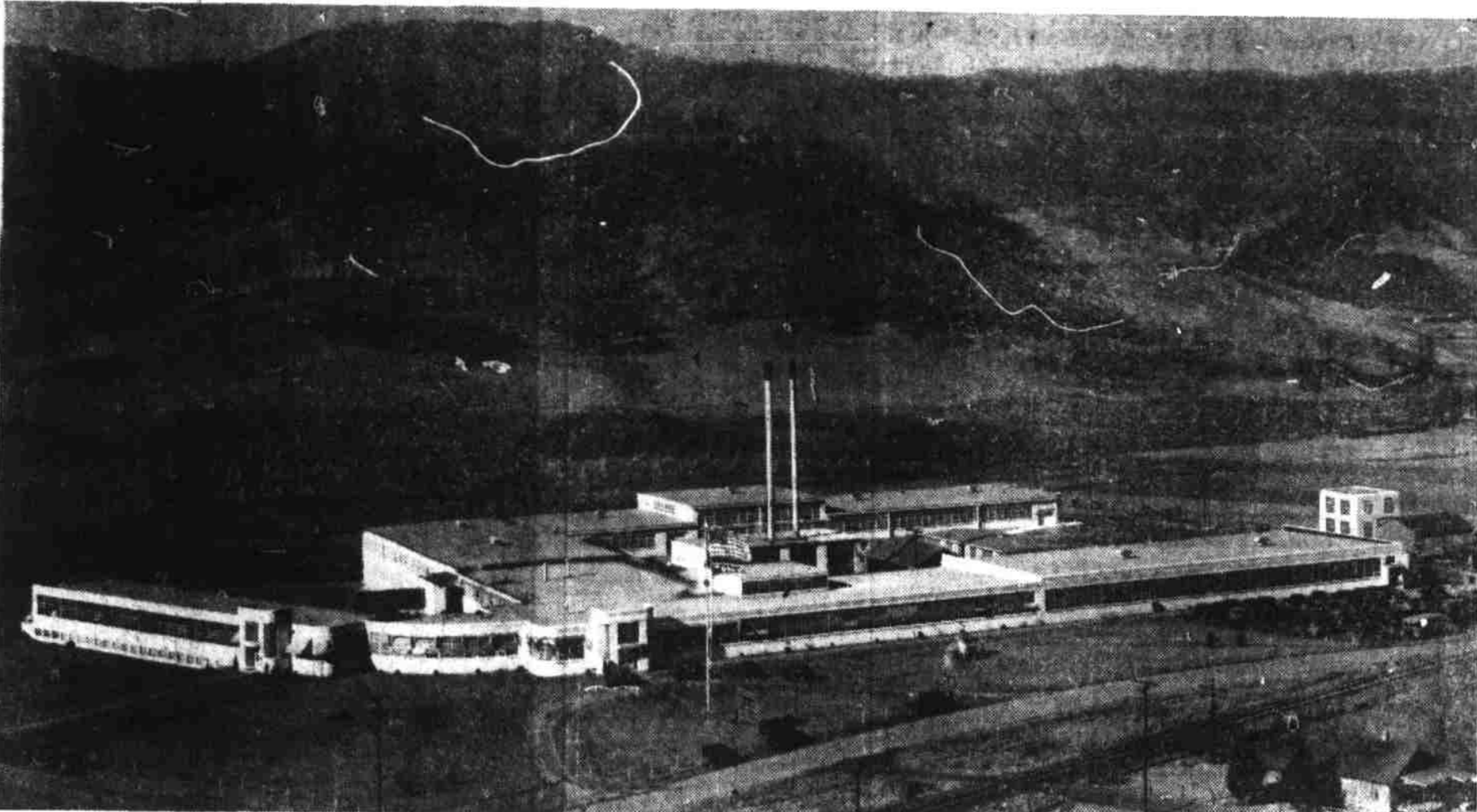
The Rev. Malcolm R. Williamson will attend the meeting of the Synod of Appalachia in Chattanooga next Tuesday and Wednesday.
