#### Rules Announced For New Tobacco Allotments

The closing date for filing applications for new grower tobacco allotments has been set for Janucry 31, according to an announcement by R. C. Francis, chairman of the county AAA committee.

A new farm means a farm on which tobacco was not produced in any of the five years from 1941 through 1945, but on which tobacco will be produced in 1946, it was pointed out by Mr. Francis.

An application for an allotment shall be filed with the county committee prior to February 1, of this year, unless the farm operator has been in the armed services, in which case such application shall he filed prior to February 1 or not later than sixty days following the date of his discharge, which ever is later, according to Mr. Francis.

A tobacco acreage allotment shall not be established for any new farm unless each of the following conditions have been met;

The farm operator shall have had experience in growing the kind of tobacco for which an allotment is requested either as a sharecropper tenant or as farm operator during two of the past five years in the case of Burley tobacco; except that farm operator who has been in the armed service shall be dependent on the farm covered by the application for his livelihood; the farm covered by the application shall be the only farm owned or operated by the farm operator on which any Burley tobacco is produced and no kind of tobacco other than the kind for which application for an allotment is made will be grown on such farm in 1946.
