A Hint to Beginner Cooks-Bake the Pie Crust First

By BETSY NEWMAN

IN my early days of cooking and baking until nearly he present, I never baked a pie crust first except in cases where the "lling was completely cooked and poured in the baked rust then the meringue put on and browned in a slow oven. couldn't see how n crust that had been batted could be kept from burning when a filling was put in and the whole thing baked again.

Possibly some of you new cooks will have the same feeling, so in the two pie recipes I'm giving you today, go boldly ahead and you will come out all right. Putting the unbaked crust into a very hot oven for 10 mins or so and then lowering the heat when you are baking a custaid mix pie, used to do the trick, but the baking of the crust first is beite..

Today's Menu Pork Chops Apple Sauce Boil d Rice

Cabbage and Onion Salad Pumpkin or squash or Sweet Potate Pie Coffee

Cabbage and Orion Salad Shred the cabbage and cut the onions into very thin rings. Season

Pumpkin or Squash Pie 1 1/2 c. cooked 1/4 tsp. allspice pumpkin or squash 1/4 tsp mace 1/2 top. salt 2 eggs 1 c. milk 1/2 c. sugar 2 thsp. butter

1 tsp. cinnamon Pastry Heat pumpkin or squash, milk, sugar, spices and sale in a double boiler, add beaten eggs and butter and mix well. Pour the hot filling into a deep baked pastry shell and bake in a n.oderate oven (350 deg. F.) about 30 mins., or until filling

Sweet Potate Pie 11/2 c. boiled, 3/2 tsp. ginger riced sweet 1/2 tsp. salt 2 eggs potatoes 2 ° milk 2 tbsp. butter

4 c. sugar Pastry
Has aweet potatoes, milk, sugar, ginger and sall in a double boiler. Pour some of the hot mixture into the beaten eggs, mix all together, and add butter. Pour hot filling into a deep based pastry shell and bake in a moderate oven (350 deg. F.) for about 30 mins.
