





Recognized By U.S. Contract For New Canton

Building Let Robinson Brothers Construction Company of Asheville, has been on the Cunard cargo ship Eros and awarded the contract for the new Crowder building on Main street, Canton, it was announced by Olfa Crowder, owner, yesterday. The building, located on the Crowder lot opposite Rose's Store, will cost around \$15,000. It will become the new home of Crowder's, will house the printing company, Crowder's Typewriter Exchange and Office Supply House of which Mr. Crowder is owner.

Henry I Gaines is architect for the building which will have a frontage of 33 feet on Main street and will extend for a depth of 65 feet. The structure will contain two stores and will be of fireproof construction. The framework will be ot steel and the floors will be concrete, covered with rubber tile, Mr. Crowder stated. The front will be of cream brick with marble settings.

Mr. Crowder is active in civic affairs of the community and is one of Canton's youngest business men. He is a member of the Canton Lions club, and assistant Scoutmaster of troop 48 at Candler. 




