

Social Security Representative Here On 29th

A representative of the Asheville field office of the Social Security Board will be at the court room, court house here, on Tuesday, the 29th, at 10 a. m. weather permitting.

Wage earners who have worked on a job covered by the Social Security Act since December 31, 1936, and have attained the age of 65, may be eligible to file claims for themselves, their wives, or minor children, whether they have an account number or not. Surviving relatives of deceased workers, such as widows, children or parents or if none of the above persons who have paid funeral expenses may be eligible to file claim.

In addition persons who have need of social security account numbers or other information pertaining to the Act are invited to meet this representative at the time and place mentioned.

Former Canton Teacher Discharged From Navy

Timely, Practical Household Suggestions

The fit of a slip depends not only on its size but also on its cut. Clothing specialists remind us that slips sold so widely in stores usually fit slender figures but stretch-cut slips are better suited to stout figures and large hips. Stretch-cut slips stay down better over the knees when sitting and are less likely to hang unevenly and "cut under" at the back, which gives an especially ugly appearance with sheer dresses.

What makes for a good buy in bedspreads is also for a good buy in pillow-cases—firm weave, little slant, torn length, smooth and even hems.

A word about sizes: Pillow-cases the large wrinkle under the head, the too small bunch up the pillow into a hard lump and are likely to be strained. Your best bet is a pillow 12 inches wider and 6 inches longer than the pillow.

When you buy bath towels you must sometimes compromise between durability and drying power. A towel that dries well is soft, light, has little twist in the pile and a loose foundation. So look for a towel with a firm foundation and soft loops about 1/8 inch long, rather than close-together, but not too tightly twisted.

Other earmarks of a good towel: Firmly woven with the crosswise warp securely wrapped around the lengthwise or warp yarns; hems at least 1/2 inch wide with 1/4 inch allowance of a raw edge turned under for neatness.

for most of her wartime career in enemy waters, but it was not until August 9, 1945, five days before Japan capitulated, that she actually engaged the enemy.

about 1,500 yards off the port bow. She swung to ram the new intruder, which crash-dived to escape.

A five-inch direct hit holed and sank the first submarine while Johnnie Hutchins hurled patterns of depth charges at the second. During the search for No. 2, a third sub was picked up only eight miles from the scene of the first encounter. Heavy depth charges pro-

duced an underwater explosion heard for several miles, and gave his little ship claim to a "probable" sinking and an added bit of glory in the closing days of the war.
