NEW YORK—Fala the celebrated canine companion of the late President Roosevelt, has been a screen actor many times in newsreels but now he emerges as a full-fledged actor. The former White House pet has the lead in a one-reel technical film called "Fala at Hyde Park."
 Filmed during the late fall of 1944 and re-edited after the President's death, it contains the only technical pictures known to have been made of President Roosevelt. They also were the last films taken of him before the Yalta conference. The brief movie recounts Fala's activities as the Dog-of-the-Manor-on-the-Hudson.
