Q. What happens to housing construction begun before January 15, when this plan goes into effect, but which comes within the price ceiling and on which veterans will be given preference?

Builders in this class may apply for HH ratings for any necessary critical materials.

Q. What about the housing be before January 15, but on which the sales or rental prices will excede the ceiling?
