Soviet Prisoners Screened By U. S.

WASHINGTON - The United States agreed to return to Russia only those war prisoners who actually lived there when the war the Pentagon Building this week started, it developed this week.

This apparently made it unnecessary for White Russians to return to the Soviet Union.

The State Department released the text of the repatriation agreement signed at Yalta, whose existence was disclosed by the White House on Feb. 12. It dealt with the return of Russians taken in the course of the fighting in Europe and provided:

"In the implementation of this agreement the United States government is facilitating a repatriation to the Soviet Union of only those persons who were both citizens of and actually domiciled within the Soviet Union on Sept.
