This Is The Bookkeeping Department



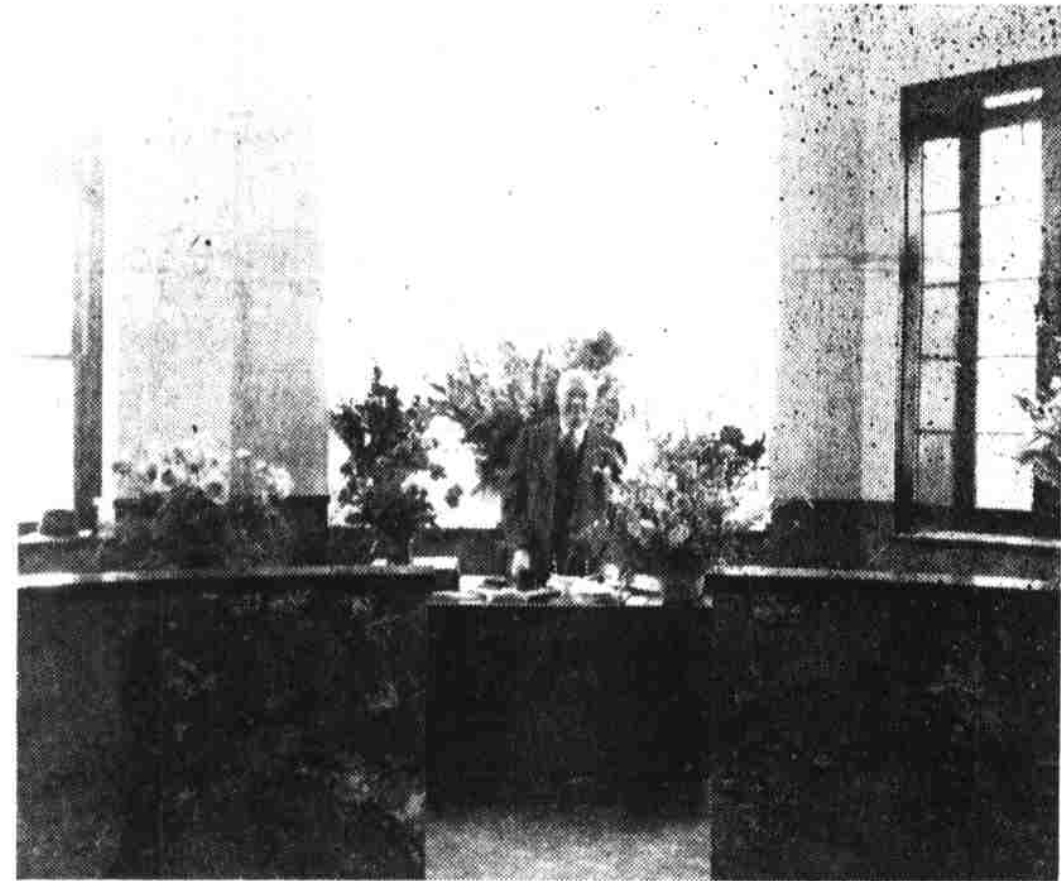
