Well, we found ourselves in that state of affairs this afternoon, so we decided to go afield in that land we love the best - Books.

And the first one we picked up, "GOD BLESS OUR AUNTS," written by Rachel Meisenhelder, gave us such a hilarious inward feeling that we went right ahead with this column. When you feel that the world has a bluish tinge, read "GOD BLESS OUR AUNTS." You'll know that a grand and glorious time was had by all - including yourself - and that the world had bleached itself out into the prettiest white you ever saw.

Carl Goerch is a North Carolina tradition, every one reads and enjoys whatever finds his signature at the end. It is wrong to think that traditions only pertain to aged articles.

For Carl Goerch is anything but traditionally old. Neither are the anecdotes he tells about friends and foes alike. No, that isn't correct for we do not believe he ever had a foe. Even those who feel the sharp snap of his linguistic wit take it in good grace and come back for more. In his newest book, "CHARACTERS - ALWAYS CHARACTERS," you will find some of the cleverest writing you ever read - and about people you know.

One of the best movies that has come to the screen in a long time is the picture "THE GREEN YEARS," from the novel written by A. J. Cronin. Many of those who did not read the novel when it first came out, now are asking for it after seeing the picture.
