


Our Supreme Need

Calvin Coolidge, during the trying days of the 1920's, issued this warning:

"We do not need more national development; we need more spiritual development. We do not need more intellectual power; we need more moral power. We do not need more knowledge; we need more character. We do not need more government; we need more religion. All of our learning and science, our culture and our arts will be of little avail unless they are supported by high character. Unless there be honor and truth and justice, unless our material resources are supported by moral and spiritual resources, there is no foundation for progress. A trained intelligence can do much but there is no substitute for morality, character and religious convictions. Unless these abide, American citizenship will be found unequal to its task."

These words are as true today as when they were first uttered. Every generation must be instructed in moral and spiritual values, and to be most effective such instruction should begin in childhood. To "teach a child the way he should go" is still the essence of wisdom.
