NEW YORK (AP)—The United Nations will pay a \$15,000 stipend to the moving company that will pack the moving trunk of the United Nations in the organization's office.

After receiving the check, the check was given to the United Nations to be used for the purchase of a new office building in New York City.

The offer was made by James J. O'Neill, president of the United States House of Representatives.

This transfer, Mr. O'Neill said, will be a contribution to the United Nations.

Hirohito Is Saved From Petticoat Rule

TOKYO (AP)—A newly-attained emperor will soon penetrate the Palace of Peace. A special legislative council, the Imperial Household Law, decided the point today.

All councilmen agreed that "democratization" as well as a woman could not be allowed to succeed to the Japanese throne.

The trouble was that the emperor's mother, Empress Dowager Teimei, had no one to succeed her, and the husband of an Empress could have any authority over the king.

Japan hasn't had an Empress since the eighth century.

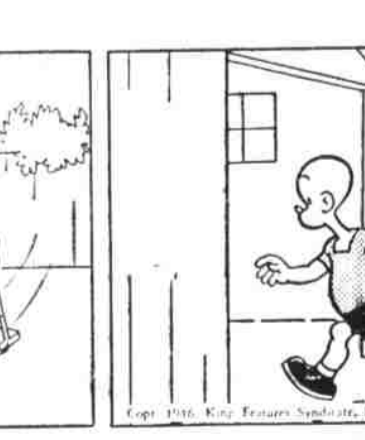
