

Remove Murphy-Pirst Sunday 8:00 A.M. stem ends, peel, quatrer, Bring toundees to a colling boil, sturring

tomatoes heat in their juice. Pack clean, bot jars with hot tomatoes and add a teaspoon salt to each quart. Cover with hot julce to within one-half inch of jar top. Adjust jar lid, according to its type. Read directions that come with tops.

Process or heat in the boiling water bath canner-this way. Heat pint or quart jars of tomatoes in the bath of boiling water for 10 minutes.
