Farm And Home Group Asks That State College Get Expansion Funds

Group Adopts Resolutions Urging Improvements In N. C. Rural Areas

A \$5,000,000 program of expanding N. C. State College and increased salaries at the institution was requested by the 3,000 delegates attending the annual Farm and Home week at Raleigh last week.

Their endorsement of the program, which will be submitted to the next general assembly, was based on the college's "valuable contributions to the welfare and living standards of the rural people of North Carolina."

The delegates, including 21 from Haywood county, passed a number of resolutions at their Thursday session.

U. S. To Auction Ships At Antwerp

A representative of the United States Office of Naval Administration announced that all surplus American vessels and harbor craft of Antwerp, Belgium, would be auctioned in a series to speed disposal of war-time surplus remaining in Europe.

Craft to go on the block, and used to support the Allied invasion force, in June 1944 include 115 seacraft, 10 motor tractor tugs, 41 barges, and 43 landing craft convertible to cargo-carrying 60,000-pound capacity each. The equipment is valued at the United States \$7,000,000.

But also included within the list are 100 motor launchers in British, Mediterranean, and German ports.
