Summer Visitors Break Pisgah Forest Records

A record number of summer visitors is flocking to the Pisgah National forest, the scenic wonders of the forest, the swimming pools, the picnic areas and the hiking trails.

"The number of sightseers, picnickers and others far exceeded our expectations," he stated, "and cars from practically every state in the union can be seen driving through the forest each day."

On week ends a check-up reveals that approximately one car per minute enters the entrance to the forest near Pisgah Forest, and Ranger Huber said it would be impossible to even try to estimate the number of persons who have visited in the forest this summer.

"Thousands of people are enjoying the beautiful drive to Mount Pisgah, leaving their cars at the scenic parking area and hiking to the peak of Pisgah to see the magnificent valleys below," he said.

Rozner directs the White Russian State Jazz Band, and tickets always are sold out for his shows. He says he picked up his technique and "jazz sense" in his youth in New York's Harlem.

Izvestia commentator E. Groshov conceded that Rozner opened one of his programs with a well-liked Russian melody but said its strains soon were "drowned in a sea of rampant trifles set to jazz."
