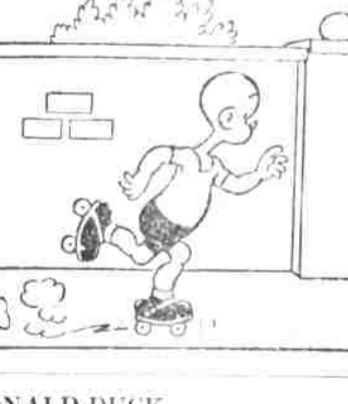

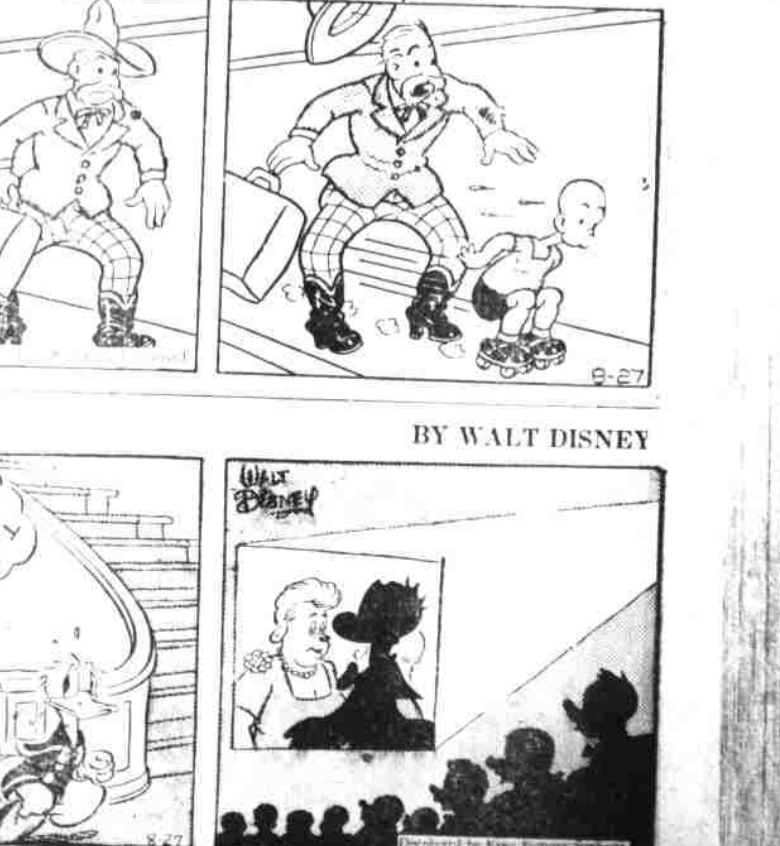

RECORD GRAIN CROPS

The agriculture department has reported that Aug. 1 conditions indicated a record-breaking crop of 3,496,826,000 bushels of corn and 1,169,366,000 bushels of wheat. The previous record corn crop was 3,203,310,000 bushels produced in 1944; the record wheat crop was produced in 1945, 1,123,143,600 bushels.
