

# IS YOUR CITY SAFE?



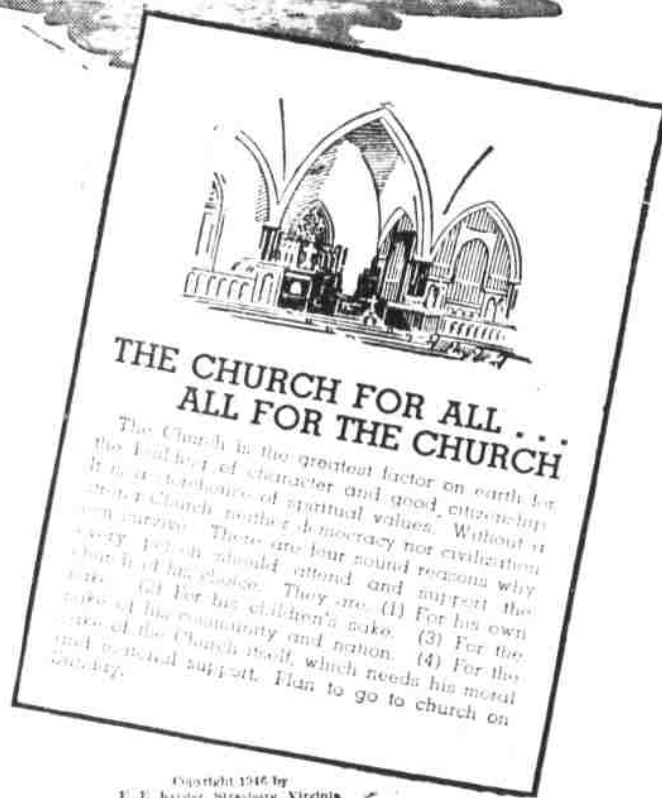
