The Federal Farm Administration, which has been in charge of the Federal loan program since the passage of the Farm Security Administration Act in 1943, will be replaced by a new agency, the Farm Credit Administration, which will take over the Federal loan program on Oct. 1, 1946.

In a recent election held at Duke University Law School, Willis N. Smith, Jr., of Raleigh, has been chosen president of the Duke Bar Association, which includes in its membership all students enrolled in the law school.

Another program the new agency will administer is one insuring mortgages. A "farm tenant-mortgage insurance fund" of \$25,000,000 will be asked of Congress, and the program will not go into effect until the appropriation is made.

Loans under the FHA may also be made to farmers and stockmen for the purchase of livestock, seed, feed, fertilizer, farm equipment and supplies, other farm needs, the refinancing of indebtedness and for family subsistence. The

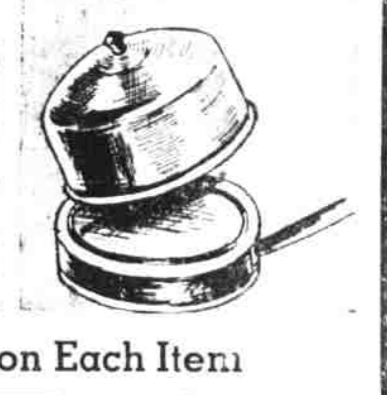

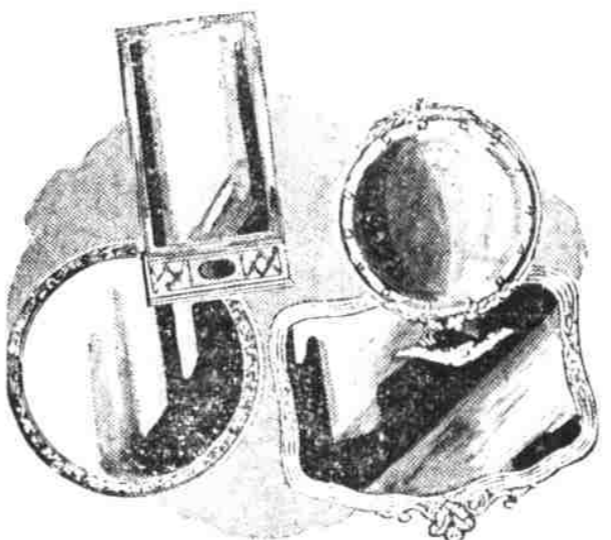

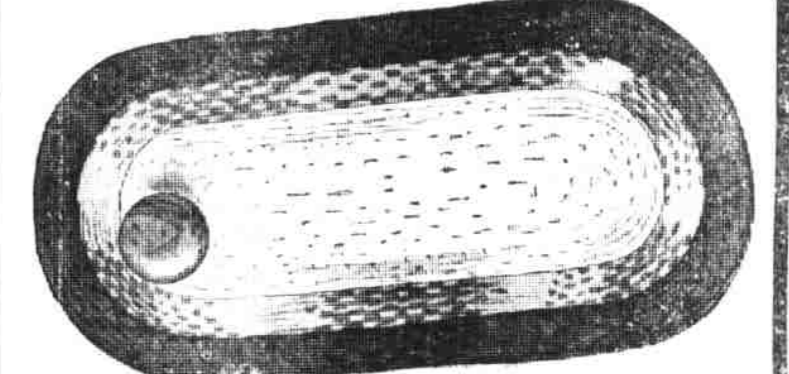
