Discussions at the meeting will emphasize the Forest and Parks program of the Department, which the General Assembly will be asked to expand. Chairman Josh Horne, Rocky Mount, will preside.

Etheridge urged all citizens having problems or suggestions concerning matters within jurisdiction of the board to appear at the public hearings.

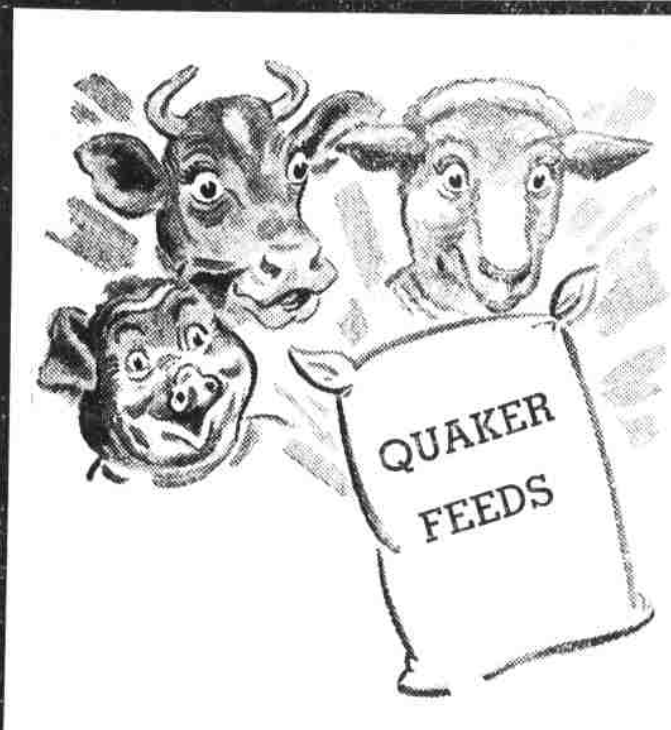
