Drunken Driving Is On Increase In This State

Increase of Almost 350 Cases Over Last January, Report Shows

During January, 934 persons lost their driving licenses in North Carolina because of drunken driving.

Revocations and suspensions processed during January totaled 1,287. That figure included 67 persons caught driving drunk outside the State; 86 driving drunk and miscellaneous; 24 driving after license had been revoked; and 31

for transporting liquor. Thirty persons lost their driving privileges for speeding over 75 miles per hour; 13 for larceny of automobile; 10 for improper use of operator's license; 8 for two offenses of reckless driving; and 3 for failure to comply with the financial responsibility act.

During the month, 334 persons were convicted of reckless driving; however reckless driving requires no revocation or suspension on first offense.

Light Up Poultry

Artificial lights should be used regularly in the poultry house and should be continued without interruption throughout the entire season.

The industrial philosophy of the Champion Paper and Fibre company is based on "invention, investment and integration," Reuben B. Robertson, president of the company, told members of the Asheville Civic Club at a luncheon meeting Tuesday in the George Vanderbilt hotel.

About the time the Canton plant was founded, the Champion company acquired large spruce areas in the Great Smoky Mountains, Mr. Robertson said.

Remarking that the company had never hesitated to break with tradition when such action was in the interest of progress, Mr. Robertson described the largest paper-making machine in the world, which he said is in operation in the Canton plant.

He cited these two features of the company's industrial relations program: (1) an age-service bonus which gives workers a five per cent automatic wage increase for every five years of unbroken service up to 25 years, and (2) a production bonus, which he described as "a simplified profit-sharing plan."
