**NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION FOR THE EXTENSION OF THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF WAYNESVILLE.**

At a meeting of the Board of Elections of Haywood County held at the court house in the Town of Wayneville on the 24th day of May, 1948, with all members present, to-wit:

Jerry Rogers, James Smilgerton and Claudi Williams, it was ordered as follows:

That pursuant to Chapter 725 of the Session Laws of North Carolina for 1947, and other laws of North Carolina the Mayor and Board of Aldermen have directed and requested by order duly adopted, that an election be called relative to the corporate extension of the Town of Wayneville, as hereinafter set forth, to be held on the 3rd day of July, 1948, relative to the extension of the corporate limits of the Town of Wayneville to include the territory hereinafter designated, which election shall be held pursuant to the laws of North

Carolina relating to special elections as hereinafter set forth.

That Horace Duckett is hereby appointed Registrar of said election, and that Guy Messer and Irvin Leatherwood are appointed Judges of said election.

That said election shall be held at the East Wayneville school house within the territory hereinafter described, which place is designated as the polling place.

That at said election those favoring the corporate extension to include the territory hereinafter described shall vote a ballot on which shall be written or printed the words "For Extension" and those opposing such corporate extension will vote a ballot with the words

written or printed thereon "Against Extension."

That the territory proposed to be annexed and to be included within the corporate limits of the Town of Wayneville is bounded and described as follows:

**BEGINNING** at a stake in the center of East Street in Wayneville city limit line, and runs with the center of East Street the following calls: N. 39° 30' E. 272 feet, N. 37° 30' E. 200 feet, N. 24° E. 152 feet, N. 44° 45' E. 100 feet, N. 72° E. 238 feet to the forks of a street, thence continuing with the center of East Street N. 24° 15' E. 200 feet, N. 16° 45' E. 352 feet, N. 20° 50' E. 286 feet, thence N. 30° E. 200 feet, thence N. 0° 40'

E. 182 feet to the edge of the pavement of State Highway No. 19-23; thence crossing Highway No. 14-35° E. 1271 feet to a spanish oak on top of a ridge; thence S. 72° 10' W. 600 feet to a fence stake on the North bank of the road, thence S. 81° W. 680 feet to a large chestnut West of the top of the ridge West of Bob Leatherwood's dwelling; thence N. 85° 30' W. 498 feet to a small black oak on ridge; thence N. 29° 10' W. 184 feet to a stake; thence N. 41° W. 125 feet to a white oak; thence S. 75° 35' W. 118 feet to a spanish oak near R. R. Gibson's dwelling; thence S. 73° 20' W. 1457 feet crossing the railroad to a stake in Wayneville City limit line; thence with

Waynesville City limit line to a BEGINNING.

It is further ordered that the Registrar proceed to open the books for the registration of voters and that all persons within the territory herebefore described desiring to participate in said election are hereby notified to register for said election, and that said Registration and election shall be held by the Registrar and Judges, as provided by law.
