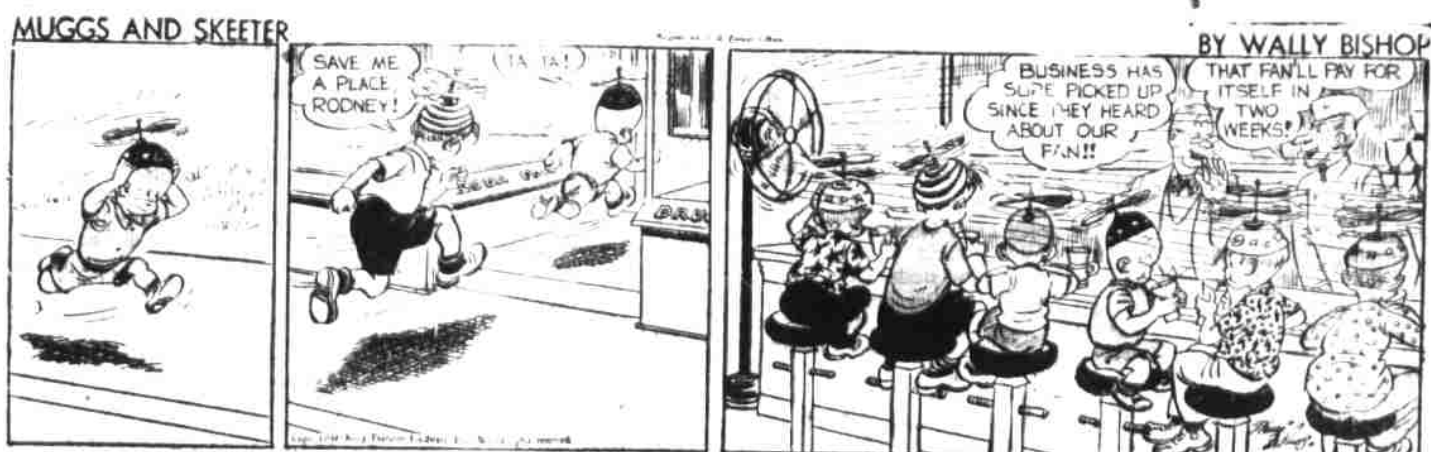

**NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION FOR THE EXTENSION OF THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF WAYNESVILLE**

At a meeting of the Board of Elections of Haywood County held at the court house in the Town of Waynesville on the 29th day of June, 1948, with all members present, to-wit: Jerry Rogers, James Singleton and Claude Williams, it was ordered as follows:

That pursuant to Chapter 725 of the Session Laws of North Carolina for 1947, and other laws of North Carolina, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen having directed and requested, by order duly adopted, that an election be called relative to the corporate extension of the Town of Waynesville, as hereinafter set forth, and pursuant to the request of said Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Waynesville an election having been ordered to be held on the 3rd day of July 1948, and it appearing that due notice has not been published sufficient time before the registration, and in order that said election may be held in full requirement of law, it is ordered by the Board upon motion duly seconded and by unanimous vote of the members of the Board of Election of Haywood County, that said special election as ordered, be cancelled and not held on the 3rd day of July, 1948, and it is ordered by the Board of Elections of Haywood County that the said election be held on the 4th day of September, 1948, relative to the extension of the corporate limits of the Town of Waynesville to include the territory hereinafter described, which election shall be held pursuant to laws of North Carolina relating to special elections, and as provided in the statutes hereinbefore referred to.

It is ordered that Guy Messer be, and he is hereby appointed Registrar of said election, and that Robert Gibson and Wade Frazier, Jr., be and they are hereby appointed Judges of said election.

It is further ordered that this notice shall be published in The Waynesville Mountaineer, a newspaper published in the Town of Waynesville in Haywood County, once a week for thirty days prior to the opening of the registration books, and that the polling books be opened for the registration of voters in said territory proposed to be annexed at nine o'clock a. m. on Saturday, August 7, 1948, being the fourth Saturday before the date of said election, and that said registration books shall be closed at sunset on the second Saturday before said election and all persons entitled to register and vote within the territory hereinafter described are hereby given notice to register in order that they may qualify to vote in said election if they so desire, and said election shall be conducted as otherwise provided by law.

That at said election those favoring the corporate extension to include the territory hereinafter described shall vote a ballot on which shall be written or printed the words "For Extension" and those opposing such corporate extension will vote a ballot with the words written or printed therein

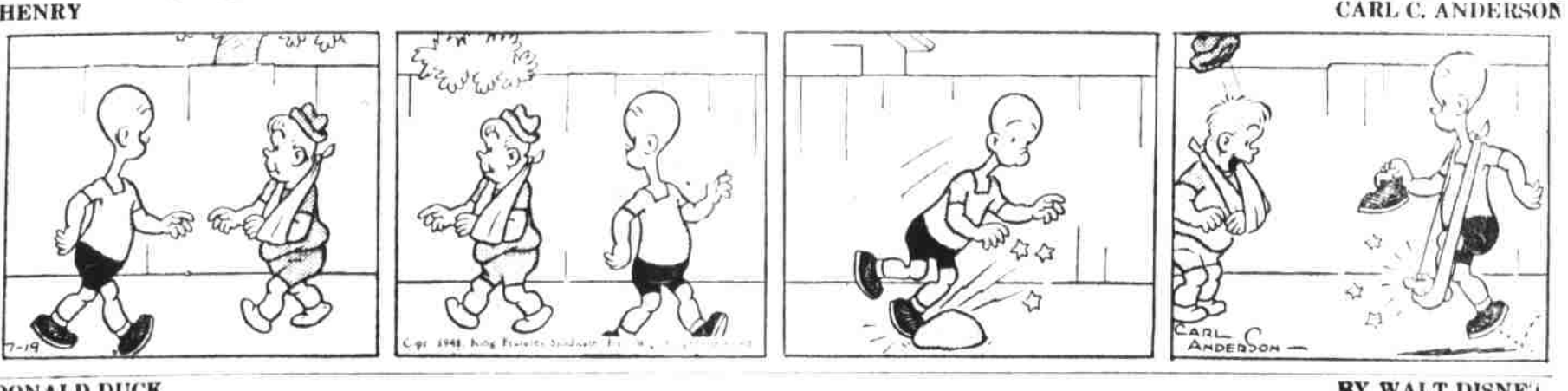
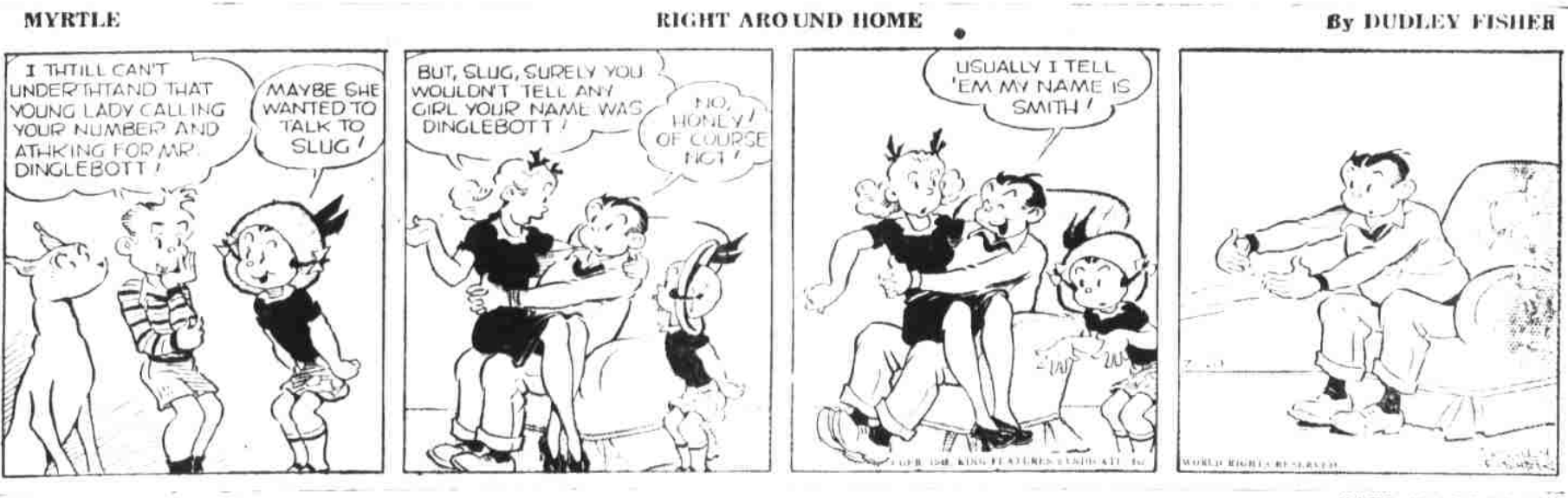
