Old Melodrama Slated For Tonight at 'Theatre In Sky'

The famous old melodrama, "The Drunkard," will be presented with all of its original pathos and humor by the "Theatre in Sky" tonight (Aug. 3) tomorrow and Friday at the Hazelwood school auditorium on Virginia avenue.

No performance has been scheduled as yet for Thursday. Season tickets will be honored at Friday's performance.

"The Drunkard" was first presented by P. T. Barnum at the Boston Museum in 1844 and has since been revived thousands of times all over the world. The play will be performed here with all of the melodramatic effects of the nineteenth century. Peanuts will be sold between scenes and audiences can throw them at the villain. The play is in 4 acts and 12 scenes with five special stage settings designed by Elma Hene Geoffrey and Ivan Lynn and is under the direction of Maurice Geoffrey.

George Pillette plays the title role and Elwyn Dearborn appears as Lawyer Cribbs, the villain. Ella Beth Hurst plays Mary with Virginia Shields appearing as her mother, Mrs. Wilson.

Doreen O'Neill Curtis will play Agnes, the mad sister, a role she played for an entire season in the Miami production of "The Drunkard."

The large cast also includes Donald E. Vogt, Melvin Penone, Robert King, Ivan Lynn, Nancy Floyd, Betty Lee Gibson, Juanita Collins, James Davis, Jewell Campbell, Valerie Lee Kaufman, Franklin Thornton, Faxe Serrano Kaufman, Marcella Louise Geoffrey and W.
