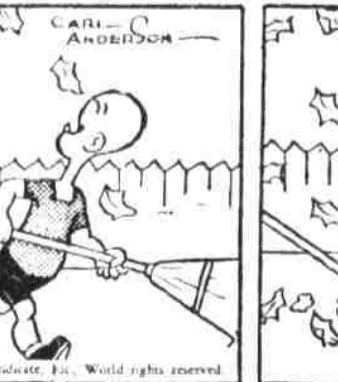
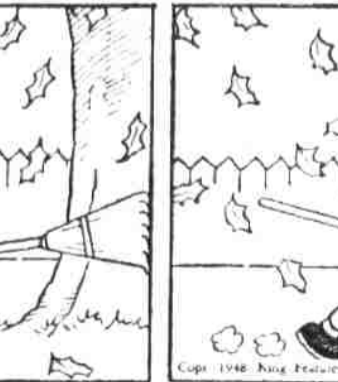

Instructions On Registration of Members of New Political Parties. The registration books will open Saturday, October 9th, and remain open for the new registration through October 23rd. During this registration period the registrars will have both the general election and party registration books, and applicants for registration will first be registered in general registration book then in primary registration book. The party with which the applicant declares his or her party affiliations, except there will be no primary registration of the Progressive Party or Peoples Rights Democratic Party. The reason of this is because the law (Sec. GS 163-144) that a new political party does not qualify for primary election unless a new party receives at least three percent of total state vote at the preceding general election. Thus, if either of two parties fail to receive three percent of the total state vote in the election of November 2nd, it could not participate in the primary election of 1950. For that reason new registration books will not be furnished for registration period preceding this coming general election. Of course, members of new parties will be registered in the general election book.
