### Motorists Have Only Few Days Before Deadline

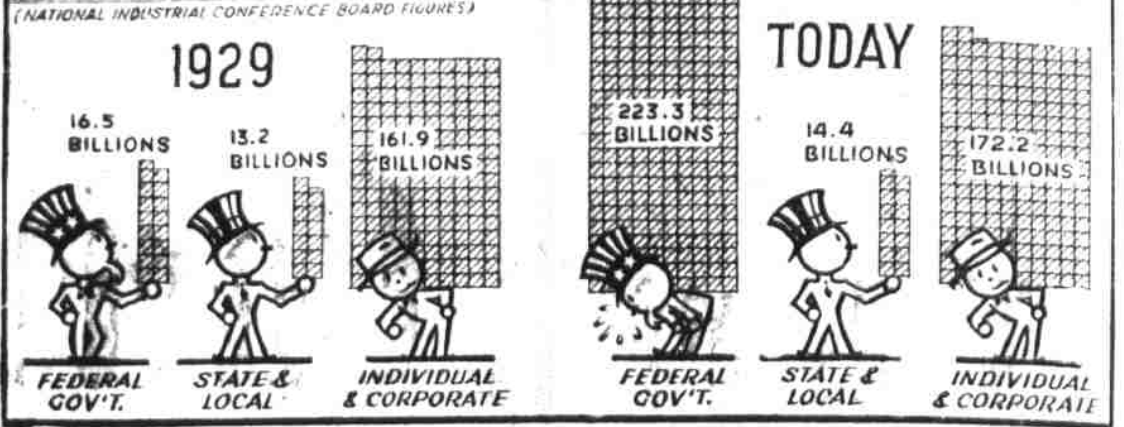
The time is fast running out for E, F and G motorists to renew their drivers license before the deadline of December 31. W. M. Moore, local license examiner, emphasized this morning.

He urged that all motorists with these surnames report immediately to his office in the court house for their examination. The local office will be closed Friday, Saturday and Monday for Christmas holidays, Mr. Moore said.

There will be absolutely no extension to the deadline, the Motor Vehicle department said, for E, F and G motorists have had since last July to get these examinations.

Beginning January 1, 1949, persons with last names beginning with H, I, J and K will begin taking their tests.

Exhibited at the American Medical Association convention here, the device fits over the nose and mouth and can be attached to a tank of pure oxygen or any other mixture.

The "nose" is a new paraphernalia which means artificial respiration. Developed first for infants, it is now used in inflexible paralysis, drowning, asthma, and other cases impairing the respiratory system.

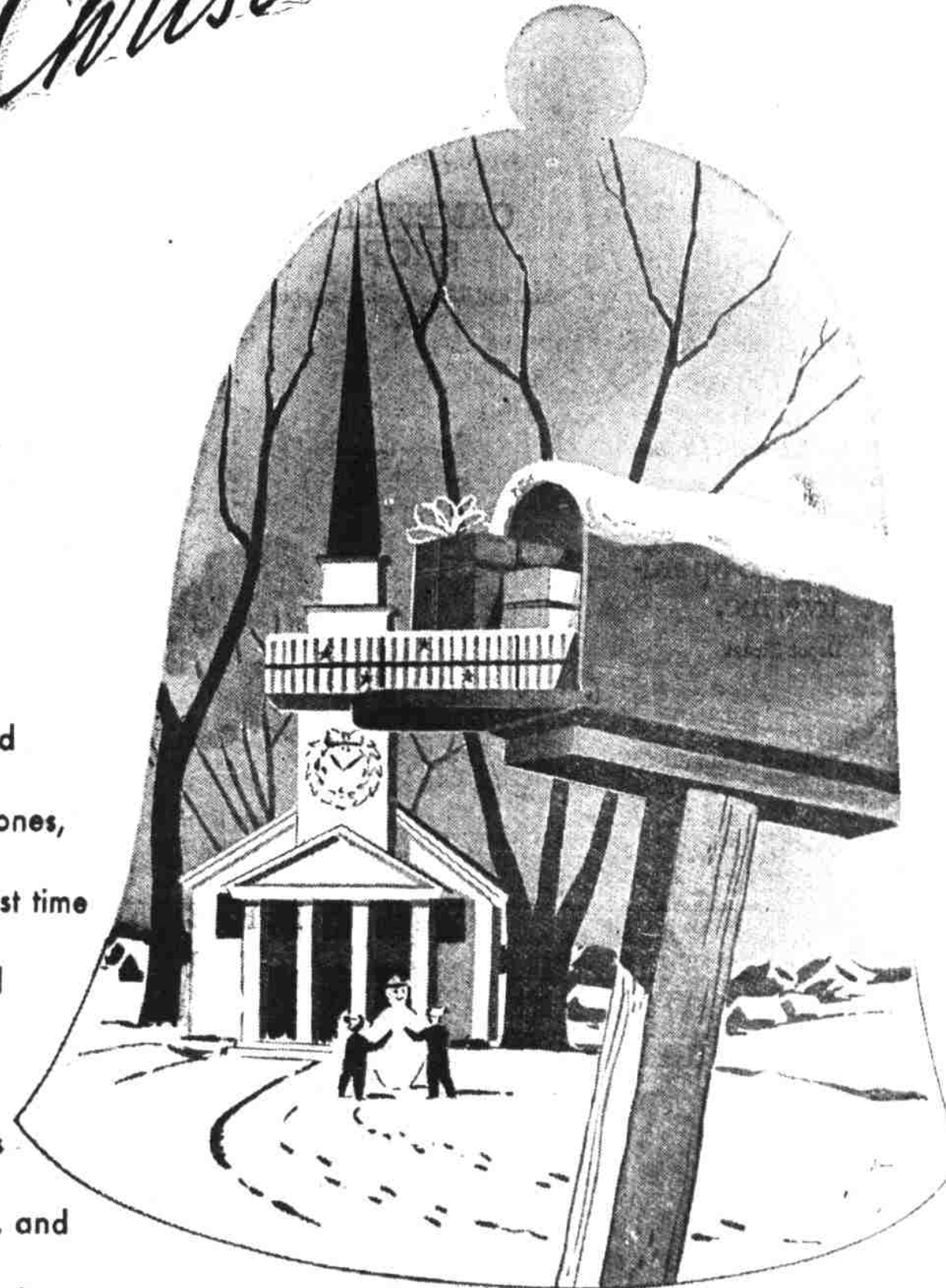
