# Farm Questions and Answers

(Compiled by Extension Service at State College)

Question: Is lime harmful to potatoes?

Answer: Agronomy specialists at State College say that the presence of lime in the soil favors the disease organism which causes potato scab. In general the heavier the liming, the more scab will develop.

Question: Is it a good practice to use sawdust as a mulch?

Answer: The main disadvantage in using sawdust is that it tends to tie up the nitrogen in the soil. Sawdust does not cause any actual loss of this plant food element nor does it cause the soil to become acid or alkaline. However, it requires extra nitrogen during the time in which it is "rotting."

Question: Which type of mill—burr, hammer or roller—is best suited to grinding grain for dairy cattle?

Answer: Agricultural engineers think that hammer mills have a slight advantage. Power needed to grind a bushel of feed is small for the hammer type mill. They have found that the hammer mill has the decided advantage that no damage is done to the feed to the mill is shut off. Most burr mills are built in such a way that the burrs are seriously damaged when the mill is kept running with no grain passing through. Few roller mills are now built.

Question: Can sodium fluoride be fed to hogs to control parasites?

Answer: The answer to that one burr, hammer or roller is best suited to grinding grain for dairy cattle? Swine specialists at State College say they know of no more effective material for combating parasites. They recommend that the material be thoroughly and carefully mixed with dry feed and fed in the proportion of one per cent of the dry feed that hogs will eat to one day.
