Modernized Sun Dial

Memphis inventor has come up with a new-type sundial.

The idea is that of Robert G. Amo, a retired Kansas oll lawyer now living in Memphis. Aided by Dr. Robert W. Hartley, astronomer and mathematics pro-

fessor at Southwestern University, Amo has devised a sundial with 110 different faces to tell accurate time each day of the year.

Not only that, but he has come up with a sundial wrist watch and pocket watch for the same pur-

Amo has applied for patents on his invention and believes they will be fool-proof-if the sun shines when you want to know the

Realizing that regular sundials one of man's oldest methods of telling time, were exact only twice year, Amo worked from there.
