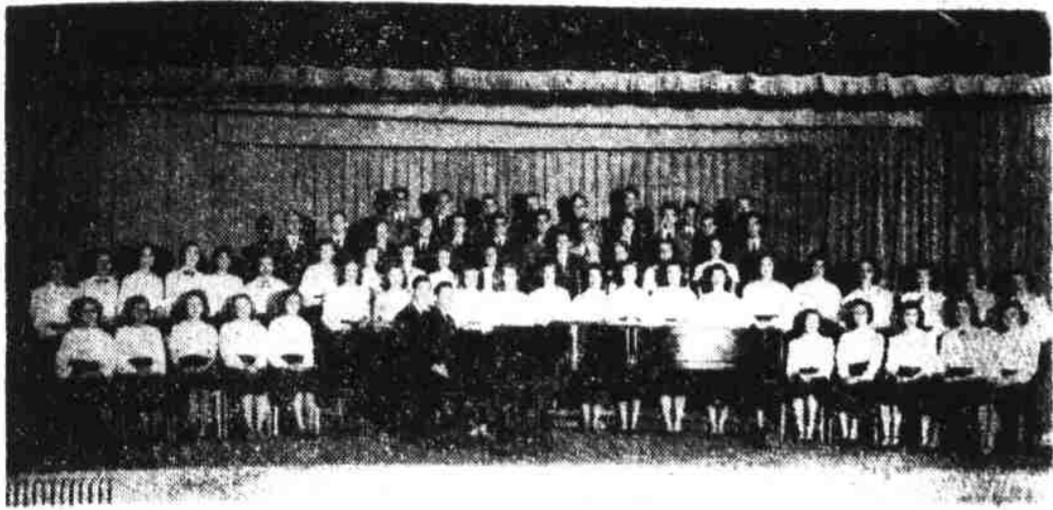

Fred I. Walston, deputy tax collector, will be at the court house from today until the 15th to assist citizens with income tax matters.

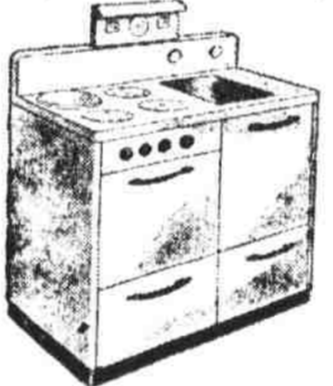
Mr. Walston is from the State Revenue Department.

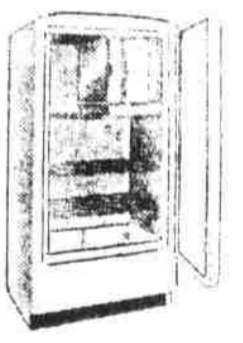
