OTTAWA, Ont. (UP) - Canadians collected a new high record of \$270,000,000 from United States travelers in 1948.

Travel expenditures by Americans in Canada went over \$200,000,000 into Canada in 1946 and in 1947 the figure was \$241,000,000. Canadian expenditures in the United States during the year were \$112,000,000.

DURHAM (UP) - It won't do much good to teach your child to obey the law if he sees you drive through red lights, a psychology professor warns.

Dr. Robert W. Lepper of the University of Oregon is doing research at Duke University here on how children learn. He says a child is likely to draw a broader conclusion from each experience than its parent realizes it does. Thus riding through a red light might convince him law doesn't have to be obeyed, despite what you say.
