MOTHER'S DAY TEA PARTY ... Cookies and Corsages

This suggestion is for teen-agers: Give your mothers a treat on Mother's Day. Join up with the daughters of your mother's friends and have a party—the guests of honor will get a big thrill out of being feted. The party doesn't have to be elaborate—just a simple tea with lots of delicious cookies. Daughters can buy the ingredients for the cookies out of their allowances and bake them in one or two kitchens.

As preparation for the party make enough small corsages or boutonnières of some pretty flowers in season so that each guest may have one. Arrange two pretty platters of cookies on a tray and place the corsages right on the tray as a decoration.

Two extra-special cookie recipes for spring are these Peck-A-Boo Cookies and Double Fudge Squares. Peck-A-Boo Cookies are an easy rolled cookie with jam or jelly pecked through a pretty design on the top layer. The jam stays put and bakes into the cookies just enough to permeate them with its sweetness and flavor.

Double Fudge Squares could easily take their name from their double goodness! But they are named for the double layer of chocolate—cookie on the bottom and frosting on the top, with a butterscotch cookie layer in the middle.

lightly greased baking sheet. Top with a half teaspoon jelly and cover with a designed cookie, lightly pressing the edges together. Bake in a moderate (350 F.) oven 10 to 12 minutes. Makes 3 1/2 dozen cookies.

**DOUBLE FUDGE SQUARES**

**Ingredients:** 3/4 cup sifted enriched all-purpose flour, 1/2 teaspoon baking soda, 1/2 teaspoon salt, 1/2 cup shortening (must be at room temperature), 1/2 cup brown sugar, 1/2 cup granulated sugar, 1 egg, 1 tablespoon water, 1/2 teaspoon vanilla, 1 1/2 cups quick rolled oats (uncooked), 1/2 cup chopped nutmeats, 1 square (1 ounce) unsweetened chocolate (melted), 1 cup semi-sweet chocolate pieces (melted).

**Method:** Sift together flour, baking soda, and salt into bowl. Add shortening, sugars, egg, water and vanilla. Beat until smooth, about 2 minutes. Fold in rolled oats and nutmeats. Divide dough into two parts. To one part, add the melted unsweetened chocolate. Roll out the light part between two sheets of waxed paper to fit a 7 x 11 inch pan. Repeat using chocolate mixture. Chill in refrigerator at least one hour. Place chocolate portion in bottom of a greased 7 x 11 inch pan. Cover with light layer. Bake in moderate oven (350 F.) 20 to 25 minutes. Cool. Spread with melted chocolate chips. Chill in refrigerator until chocolate hardens. Cut into squares. Makes 30 squares.

**PECK-A-BOO COOKIES**

**Ingredients:** 2 1/2 cups sifted enriched all-purpose flour, 1 teaspoon baking soda, 1 teaspoon salt, 1 cup shortening (must be at room temperature), 1 cup brown sugar, 1/2 cup water, 2 1/2 cups quick rolled oats (uncooked), 1/2 cup jelly or jam.

**Method:** Sift together flour, baking soda, and salt into mixing bowl. Add shortening, sugar and water and beat until smooth, about 2 minutes. Fold in rolled oats. Roll dough very thin on lightly floured board; cut with floured cookie cutter. Cut a design with a smaller cutter or a sharp knife in half the cookies. Place plain cookies on
