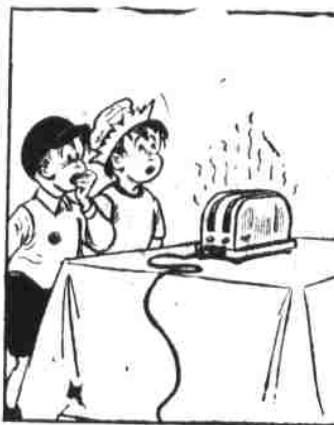

June 30 Deadline For Certain Type Driver License

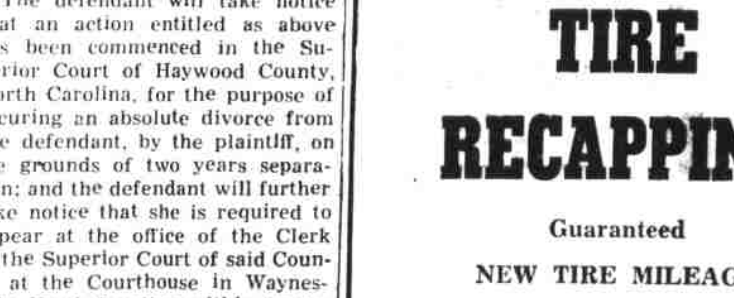
The State Motor Vehicles Department today issued a reminder that chauffeur's licenses have to be renewed by June 30. Officials estimated that 36,500 chauffeur licenses are due for renewal today. The chauffeur application blanks for 1949-50 have already been mailed by the 100 driver license examiners. They can start issuing chauffeur renewals today. June 30 is also the deadline for people whose last names start with H, I, J, or K, to have their regular driver's license renewed. Only 48,000 of the 150,000 drivers in the state in that alphabetical list have renewed their licenses so far. State officials predict a last-minute rush.

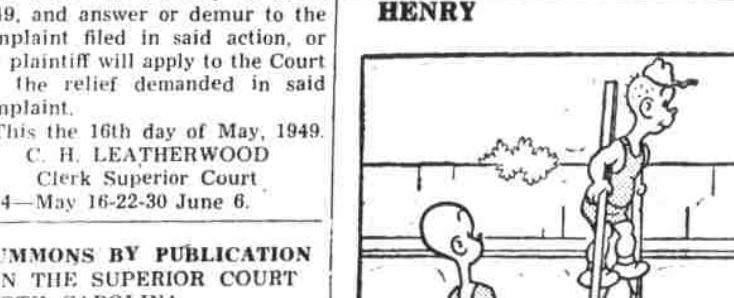
