Mr. Bryson served as principal at Crabtree-Iron Duff for the last three years.

Last week G. C. Cooper, Lake Junaluska School principal, died in a hospital after suffering a stroke while teaching a class.

Mr. Messer said the vacancies would not be filled before the current school term closes.

## 1,230 N. C. Drivers Licenses Revoked During Past April

A total of 1,230 persons lost their driver's licenses in April as a result of traffic violations, the Department of Motor Vehicles has announced.

Of this number 833 were revocations and 237 were suspensions. The figure represented a drop of 681 from 1,911 who lost their licenses during the same month last year.

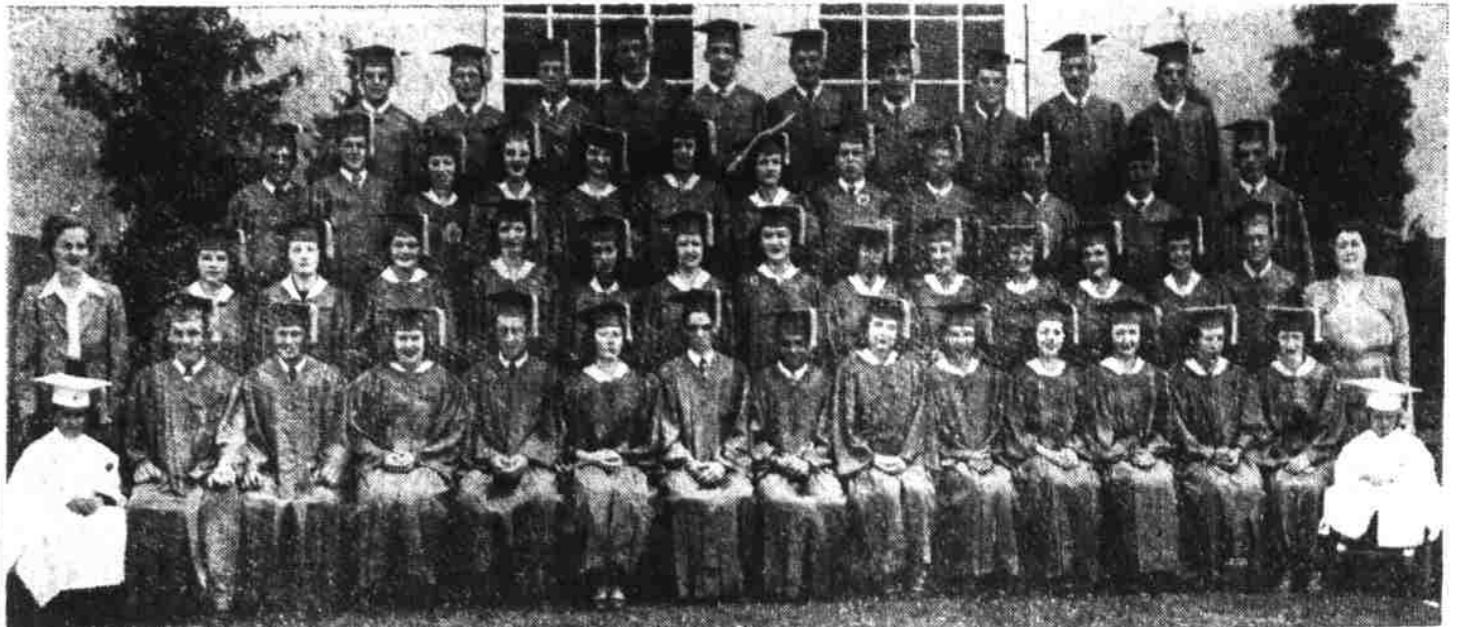
