GRUB WORMS CAUSE WORRY

Many Johnston county tobacco growers already are having trouble with grub worms in their plant beds, says W. H. Hoyle, assistant county agent for the N. C. State College Extension service.

The worms uproot the soil all over the bed, causing considerable damage to the plants. For control of the pests, Hoyle recommends using one pound of Paris Green to 25 pounds of wheat bran with enough water added to moisten the mixture and make it stick together.

The mixture should be broadcast on the bed at the rate of six to eight pounds per 100 square yards.

NAVY RESUMES SURVEY OF ALASKAN TERRAIN

SAN DIEGO (AP)—The Navy is resuming its large-scale mapping of Alaska.

Operating with the U. S. Coast Geodetic Service, the Navy's AP-40 long range reconnaissance squadron will take up where it left off last fall in making this country's first complete survey of the northern territory.

First units of the squadron left San Diego late in April to establish ground bases, four four-engine patrol planes left during May, and the last group, including Cmdr. William Davidson, who is in charge, will leave in June.

Weather conditions in Alaska made it impossible to continue the mapping operation during the winter months.

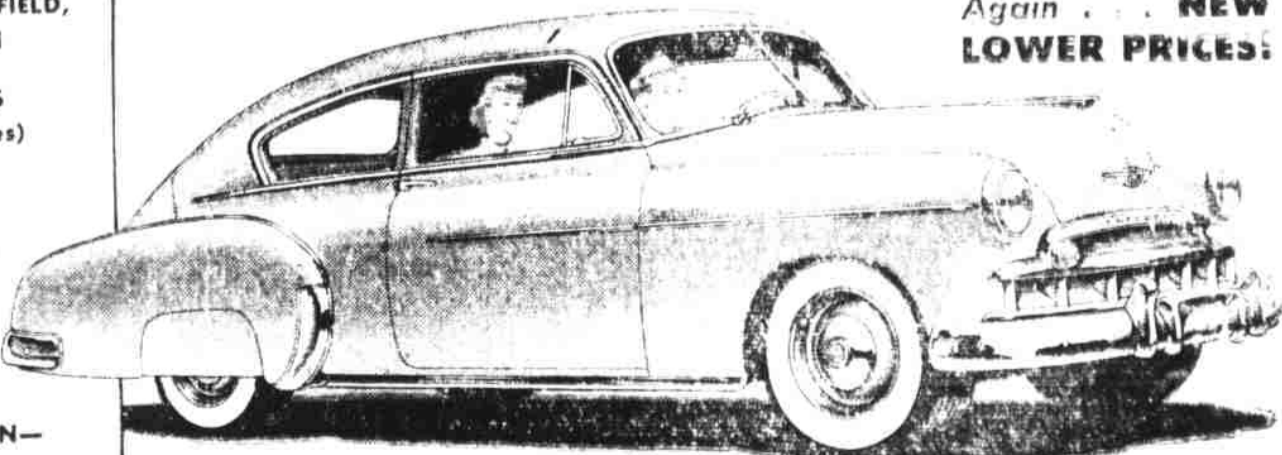
