Redden Presents Measure To Fix Forests' Lines

WASHINGTON, The House committee on conservation has introduced a measure to fix the boundary between the National Forest and the National Park. The measure is known as the National Forest Boundary Act. It is a bill to amend the National Forest Management Act of 1926, and to provide for the establishment of a National Forest Boundary Commission. The commission is to be composed of the Secretary of the Interior, the Director of the National Park Service, and three members appointed by the President. The commission is to report to the President within 60 days of its organization. The bill is expected to pass the House in the near future.
