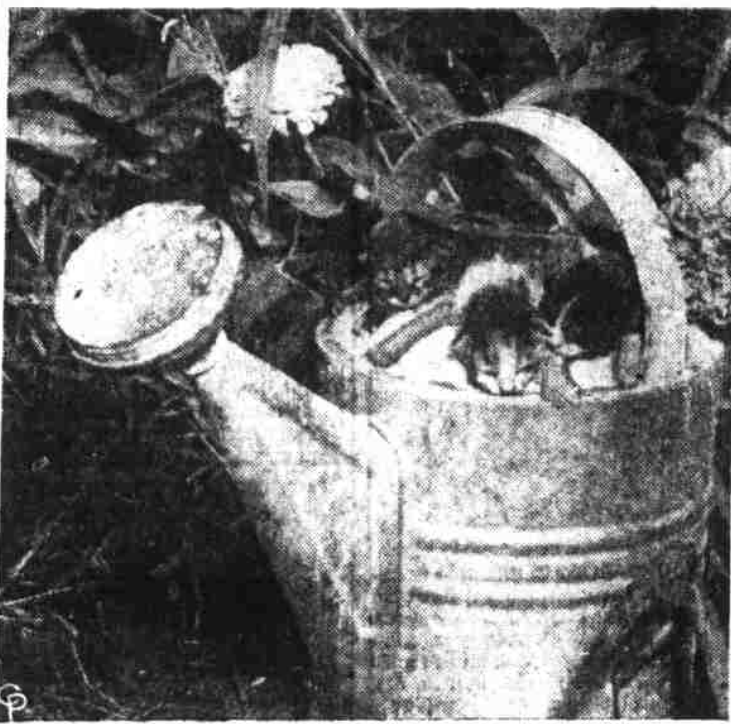
Officials of the Methodist church last week announced that the Liner bid of \$39,013 to erect the brick structure was the low one and had been accepted by the committee.

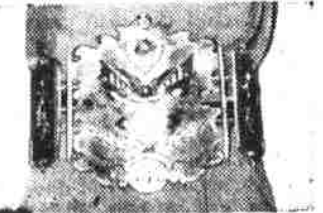

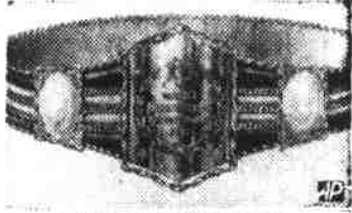

Miss Osborne operates the Lott Farm.

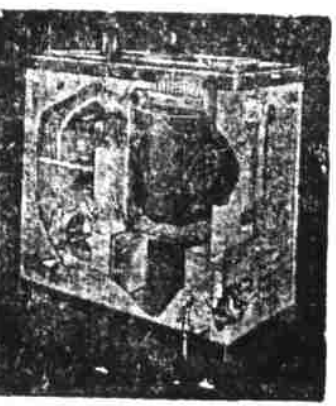
The records were supervised by North Carolina State College and reported to the American Guernsey Cattle Club, headquartered in Petersburg, New Hampshire, for approval and publication.
