## NOTICE OF HOSPITAL BOND ORDER

BE IT ORDERED by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Haywood as follows:

1. For the purpose of erecting an addition to the County Hospital bonds of the County shall be issued to the maximum aggregate principal amount of \$225,000.

2. A tax shall be levied on the principal and interest of the bonds when due shall be annually levied and collected.

3. A statement of the County debt has been filed with the Clerk and is open to public inspection.

4. This order shall take effect when approved by the voters of the County at an election as provided in the County Finance Act.

The foregoing order has been introduced and a statement has been filed under the County Finance Act showing the accrued valuation of the County to be \$29,128,805.00 and the net debt other than for school purposes, including the proposed bonds, to be \$617,000.00. A tax will be levied for the payment of the proposed bonds and interest at the same shall be levied. Any citizen or tax payer may protest against the issuance of such bonds at a meeting of the Board of County Commissioners to be held at ten o'clock A. M. August 22, 1949, or an adjournment thereof.
