**Haywood County Hospital Bonds and Tax**  
Pursuant to an order of the Board of Commissioners of Haywood County ordering a special election, as hereinafter set forth, it is ordered by the Board of Election of Haywood County that a special election shall be held in Haywood County on Saturday, the 1st day of October, 1949, at the same places at which the last election was held in said County for members of the General Assembly between 6:30 o'clock A. M. and 6:30 o'clock P. M. Eastern Standard Time for the purpose of submitting to the voters the questions (1) whether they will approve the order finally passed by the County Commissioners on August 22, 1949, authorizing \$225,000 bonds of the County for the purpose of erecting an addition to the County Hospital and the levy and collection of a tax sufficient to pay the principal and interest thereof, and (2) whether they will authorize the levy and collection of an annual tax in addition to all other taxes at the rate of 10c on each \$100 of the assessed valuation of the County for the purpose of financing the cost of operation, equipment and maintenance of the County Hospital.
